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Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command Awards Contract

SAN DIEGO – Northrop Grumman Systems Corporation (NGC), Herndon, Va., is being awarded a \$7,603,043 contract (N00039-14-C-0027) for JPEO-Chem-Bio Defense, Joint Program Manager, Information Systems, Joint Warning and Reporting Network (JWARN) software development and maintenance. This contract will provide various updates to support modernization efforts of the currently fielded JWARN product baseline, carry forward existing functionality and develop new capabilities that will provide joint automated chemical, biological, radiological and nuclear warning and reporting capability across the services.

The option periods, if exercised for NGC, would bring the cumulative value of this contract to an estimated \$31,498,929.

Contract funds in the amount of \$1,323,000 will be placed on contract at time of award, with \$668,000 allocated as fiscal year 2014 RDT&E and \$655,000 as fiscal year 2014 PROC.

Contract funds will not expire at the end of the current fiscal year.

Work will be performed in Herndon, Va. and is expected to be completed in December 2014. If options are exercised, work could continue until December 2018.

This requirement was solicited using full and open competition via the Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command E-Commerce Central website and the Federal Business Opportunities website, with three timely offers received.

The Space and Naval Warfare System Command, San Diego, awarded the contract on behalf of its organizational partner, the Joint Program Executive Office Chem-Bio Defense, Joint Program Manager, Information Systems, JWARN.
