DASN (Energy) to Present SECNAV Energy Awards

Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Navy (Energy) Joe Bryan will visit several Hampton Roads-area commands Monday, October 18, to present 2015 Secretary of the Navy Energy and Water Management awards to several commands and squadrons.

Commands receiving awards include: Carrier Airborne Early Warning Squadron 124 (VAW-124); Fleet Logistics Support Squadron 40 (VRC-40); Naval Station Norfolk; USS Mesa Verde (LPD-19); Naval Air Station Oceana; and Strike Fighter Squadron 131 (VFA-131).
